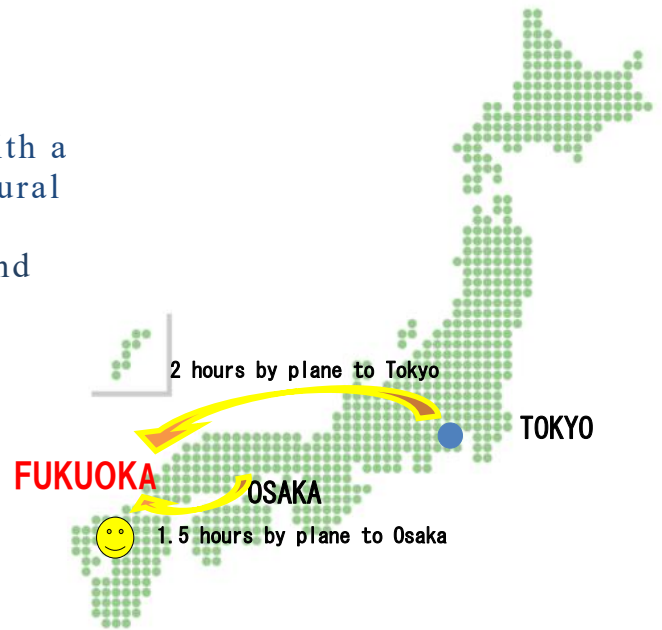
Fukuoka Prefecture is a compact city with a good balance between urban areas and natural beauty, such as the mountains and ocean.

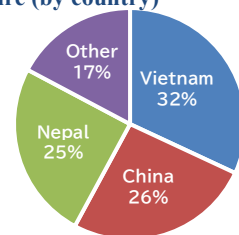

Low Cost of Living

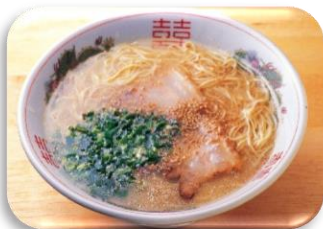

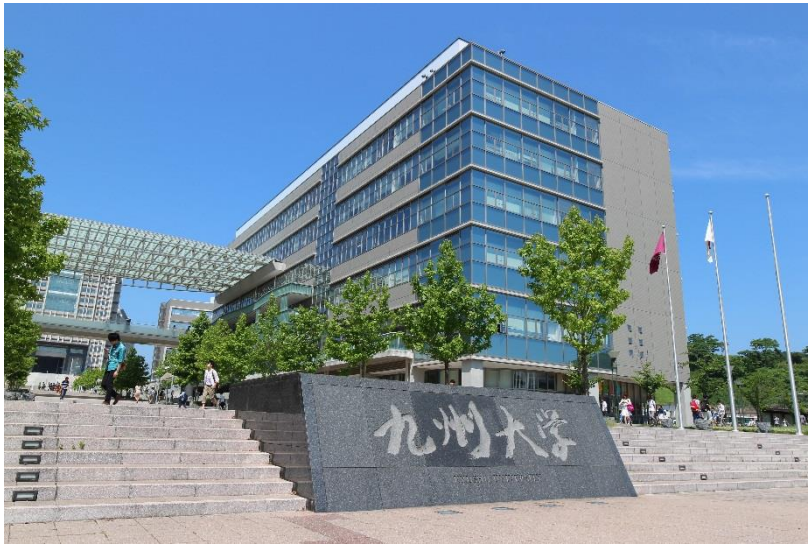

Engineering Department, 1st Year Masters (1st Semester) Tim Hosaksong (Cambodia)

I graduated from the Institute of Technology of Cambodia majoring in Intelligence Mechatronics, but my main research was about rocket propulsion. In hope of broadening my knowledge in rocket propulsion, I was awarded with a scholarship from the MEXT scholarship program and entered the Kyushu Institute of Technology. During my first year in KIT, I enrolled as a research student in the Kitagawa laboratory. Later on, I enrolled as a Master's student. My research is about designing a regenerative cooling nozzle for a hybrid rocket engine. The early period of my life in Japan was a bit difficult since I knew little Japanese. But thanks to the Japanese classes for international students at Kyutech, I learned basic Japanese which is very useful in my daily life. The professors and lab members are very friendly. Also, I really appreciate the office staff at Kyutech for their kindness and informative instruction in giving the support I need in Japan. Fukuoka is a very beautiful and peaceful place.
